Masorti Israel Milestones

Masorti Israel has reached important milestones. Masorti is building and growing. There are now 90 Masorti communities across Israel.

800,000+

The Jewish People Policy Institute reports that over 800,000 Israeli Jews identify with Masorti and other liberal streams of Judaism.

2,000+

Over 2,000 young Israelis participate in Jewish Pluralism Watch's educational activities, in Masorti's pre-army programs, gap-year, overseas leadership groups, and community service initiatives in Israel.

1,600/700+

Masorti's youth movement, NOAM, continues to expand. It's now 1,600 members strong with over 700 youth attending summer camp prior to the Coronavirus pandemic. Even during the pandemic, NOAM offered limited in-person and online programming to keep children engaged. NOAM is a major growth engine of Masorti, shaping future young Israeli leaders.

1,200/100,000+

Over 1,200 egalitarian services have been held at the Masorti Egalitarian Kotel, showcasing Masorti's "One Wall for One People" advocacy campaign. An estimated 100,000 people participated in these Kotel events prior to Covid. *Kabbalat Shabbat at the Kotel* has attracted thousands of people since its inception. During Covid, people flocked to the Kotel as a safe outdoor prayer space.

360+

This year, over 200 children with disabilities and their families were able to participate in Jewish and Israeli life thanks to Masorti's online and socially-distanced outreach programs. Families and schools across Israel were engaged through Bar and Bat Mitzvah ceremonies made possible by the ADRABA Center for Children and Youth with Disabilities. Masorti's Jack Roth Avivim Camp annually provides over 160 children with special needs inclusion in summer activities and experiences. This builds skills and confidence and develops lifelong friendships.

90/5,000+

Masorti Israel has created 90 communities across the country providing religious services, educational programs, lifecycle events, and volunteer service opportunities. Over 50% of members are Israeli born. Masorti congregations serve not only their members but also thousands from the broader Israeli community. With the assistance of the Masorti Religious Affairs Bureau, Masorti Israel officiated at over 5,000 Bar and Bat Mitzvah celebrations, weddings, conversions, circumcisions, baby namings, burials, and other lifecycle events.
